

Time to Listen Training for Club Safeguarding Officers

Time to Listen is a netball-specific, easy to follow 3 hour safeguarding workshop – delivered by experienced, netball-oriented tutors, free for England Netball Club Safeguarding Officers (CSOs). Club coaches can attend at a cost of £30 per candidate but these places will be subject to availability as priority will be given to the CSOs. *TTL is developed by England Netball and the Child Protection in Sport Unit (CPSU) of the NSPCC.

What will you learn?

What the roles and responsibilities of key people in the safeguarding process are, including your role as a Club Safeguarding Officer

How England Netball supports you, and your club, in safeguarding matters

How England Netball's reporting procedure works

What an 'Aware Club' is

How to involve young people in your club

How to develop Best Practice in your club

How government guidance/legislation relates to your role, and England Netball

Target Audience

All CAPS clubs' CSOs (Club safeguarding officers)– this is because the CAPS criteria will now include the requirement for Club Safeguarding Officers to have attended a Time to Listen Course by 1st April 2015.

To be able to attend the Time to Listen all attendees must first have attended the Sports Coach UK Safeguarding and Protecting Children, or equivalent, workshop as Time to Listen builds on this training.
